Board Action & Regulation

- Contest Managers handle all appeals
- Rule violation = DQ
- Language Content
- Manager deadline for entry
- Yearly judge certification
- Rules clinic non-completion \$50 or \$100

New Rules

- 6-Any rule violation as defined in this book shall result in disqualification from said entry.
- 6-TIME CARDS: 5 second card eliminated
- 6-LANGUAGE/CONTENT
- 6-Contest managers have the final say in all appeals.
- 7- All official Instructions and ballots for judges in all contests will be furnished on the NDHSAA website.
- 8-Burden of Proof must be shown at every tournament, including State Speech Tournaments.
- 10- Specific extemp speaking questions will be developed and posted on the NDHSAA website on a monthly basis.
- 14-Radio Time and Commentary Change
- 18-Class B schools are restricted to 4 regional/state entries per category...
- 18-Students who have qualified for state through invitationals must be registered for no more than 2 events on the regional registration form by the 7 day deadline.

New Rules

- 18-DEADLINE: Once the region registration deadline has passed, schools may not qualify additional students.
- 19-Region Managers of NDHSAA Sanctioned Fine Arts Contests are not eligible for region reimbursement or stipend unless proof of current clinic completion can be verified.
- 19- The placement of alternates will be limited to 2 at State Speech Contests.
- 19- Region managers have a 4 day deadline following their contest to edit state qualifiers
- 20- Judges must complete the annual rules clinic
- 21-Judges shall not provide any oral critique.
- 21-3 day window for late regional and state registration. Penalty of \$250 must be received by Contest Manager or NDHSAA

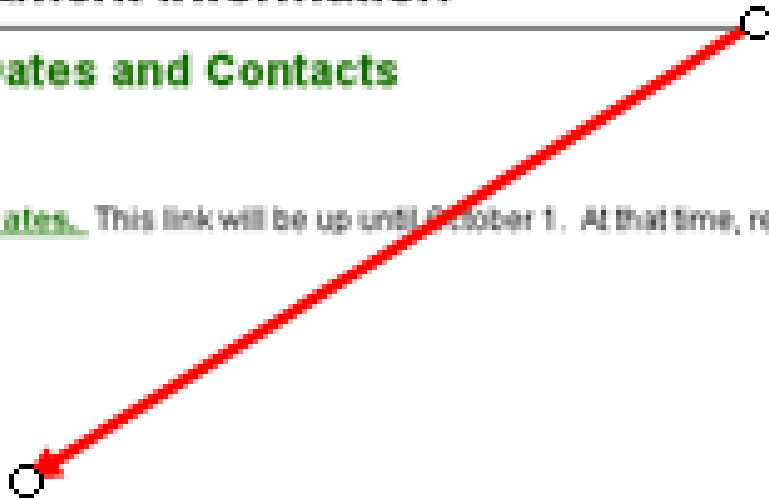
